Submittal should be a single PDF file (25 MB maximum) that includes the nomination form and supporting documentation. No letters of recommendation please. Simultaneous nomination of the same project in both Public Works Project of the Year and SC/RC Project of the Year or in two categories is not permitted. Include a separate description in less than 100 words, and in layperson's terms, why this project is worthy of special recognition. Describe the key award criteria that this project satisfies. This description will provide the basis for the Awards Ceremony overview and any Arizona Chapter publicity. Nominations not chosen in a specific year for the Public Works Project of the Year–Small Cities/Rural Communities Award cannot be resubmitted in a subsequent year in the another category.
